Our 15th Annual Family Picnic at the Lake is ready to go on Sunday, June 22nd!

The picnic will be at Shelter Number 6 of the Bloomington site of the federal park at Clinton Lake (see directions below). Day use fee has been paid for by the council for everyone!

Lunch will be served at noon but we do have the shelter reserved for the entire day. We are generally there from about 11:00 am to 4:00 pm.

BEVERAGES: The Council will provide lemonade, beer, and ice water.

FOOD: The Council will provide tableware, hamburgers, hot dogs, and the fixin's. We ask that each family bring a side-dish or dessert.

FISHING: If you desire, fishing is allowed; but, you do need a permit.

SWIMMING: Bloomington has a really fine beach to lay on or swim from - bring your suit! No steps to climb — it's on the same level as the shelter!

BOATING: There is a boat ramp at Bloomington, so bring your boat! There is a separate ramp fee.

FROM THE SOUTH SIDE OF LAWRENCE: Go South on Iowa (also highway 59) to County Road 458; west on 458 (makes several turns, so watch for signs) to County Road 6. Take 6 through town of Clinton to Bloomington.

FROM THE NORTH SIDE OF LAWRENCE: Go West on 6th Street (also highway 40) to county road 442 AKA Stull Road (442 continues west and 40 turns north). Take 442 into Stull to County Road 1023. Take 1023 south to County Road 6. Take 6 through the town of Clinton to Bloomington.
